Read, Read, Read.....June 14 – August 6

You choose one of three ways to register for our Summer Reading Program. You can pick up a “Summer Reading Log” at the library. You can install the “Beanstack Tracker” from the App store on your phone, search for “Iola Village Library” and scroll down to create an account. You can go to <http://iolalibrary.beanstack.org> and scroll down to create an account. Follow along each week to record your reading minutes and activities. We encourage families to do three or more activities each week. Read and do activities all 8 weeks and you will receive a small prize.

Where in Iola is the Tail?.....June 14 – August 6

A mysterious tail has been seen around Iola this summer. What kind of animal do you think it belongs to? Do you know where the tail is? Each week we will post a new picture on the main entrance doors, inside the library and on our Facebook page. You can check out the picture and submit your guess using the paper provided and leaving it in our book drop or inside at the desk or by emailing us your answer.
